



I understand that my dog(s) will participate in the Tuckered Out Dog Daycare program. I understand that even with extreme care in choosing groups and monitoring play sessions, that injuries can happen. I hereby acknowledge that such events may occur, and agree not to hold Tuckered Out LLC, its employees, owners, agents and other dog owners from any and all claims to any and all injuries that may occur.

I hereby waive and release Tuckered Out Dog Daycare LLC, its employees, owners, and agents from any and all liability of any nature, for injury or damage which I or my dog(s) may suffer, including specifically, but not limited to, any injury or damage resulting from the action of any dog(s). I expressly assume the risk of such damage or injury while attending any daycare, program, or other function at Tuckered Out Dog Daycare, or while on the grounds or the surrounding area.

I acknowledge that Tuckered Out Dog Daycare LLC only requires vaccination history from my veterinarian. I agree to ensure my dog(s) are in otherwise good health and able to participate in a dog daycare program. In that acknowledgement, I hereby waive and release Tuckered Out Dog Daycare LLC, its employees, owners and agents from loss or damage from disease, death or injury.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Tuckered Out Dog Daycare is dedicated to providing a happy and healthy environment for your dog(s). In doing so, it is important that customers understand and follow our policies and procedures. We welcome your dog(s) to our family!

Vaccination Requirements

Tuckered Out Dog Daycare requires proof from your veterinarian that your dog(s) currently vaccinated for the following: rabies, distemper (including parvovirus, parainfluenza, and either adenovirus or hepatitis), leptosporosis, and kennel cough.

Parasite Control and Prevention

Tuckered Out Dog Daycare also requires proof from your veterinarian that your dog(s) are treated with parasite prevention every month on a year round basis. We prefer your dog(s) are treated with Sentinel (by Novartis) as they control for the maximum amount of intestinal parasites, fleas, and heartworm. But we advise that you consult your veterinarian and we are happy to accept their recommendation for your dog(s).

We will also require a yearly fecal examination by your veterinarian, yielding a negative result. If your dog should test positive for any parasites, you must complete your veterinarians recommended treatment and then provide proof of a negative fecal before returning to daycare.

General Health

If your dog(s) is ill or has diarrhea, please do not bring them to daycare. Instead, consult with your veterinarian to determine the problem and treatment plan.

Cancellations

Tuckered Out Dog Daycare requires that you call to cancel your scheduled day of daycare before 8:30am the morning of your planned visit. You can call and leave a message any time day or night. Because we are full everyday, failure to cancel before 8:30am will result in a charge of a full day of daycare for your missed visit.

Late pick ups at the end of the day will be charged \$5.00 for the first ten minutes they are late, and then accrue an additional \$1.00 for every minute after that. Tuckered Out is a family run business, so please arrive on time to pick up your dog(s) so our staff can return to their families.

I agree to all of the above and that this contract is in effect beginning the date below and shall remain in effect on all future dates that said dog(s) attend daycare, or any other Tuckered Out Dog Daycare LLC function.
