FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING TRANSITION PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (TPP)

OUESTION	ANSWER
Who is eligible?	Students must be 16 years old and have a verifiable disability, with skill levels that demonstrate readiness for competitive employment. Students must meet eligibility requirements for the Department of Rehabilitation and have no current issues with substance abuse, law, or behavior.
How is a student referred for services?	Case managers, school staff, parent or student may refer a student for TPP services. Referrals often come from WorkAbility and TPP staff contact with students during classroom-based vocational activities.
What does the program provide?	TPP staff services can include pre-employment preparation such Job Exploration and Couseling, Workplace Readiness Training, Instruction in Self-Advocacy, Post-Secondary Counseling.
How are these services delivered?	Activities specific to TPP services are directed by the Dept. of Rehabilitation Counselor in order to assist in reaching the employment goal of the specific individual. Services are provided by both TPP staff and the Dept. of Rehabilitation Counselor (DOR).
