Allergies

Please note that we have the following allergies at our school and remind you of the importance of not sending food containing those items: Peanuts / Tree Nuts (almonds, pecans, cashew, walnuts...) egg sandwiches & Shellfish. Also, WOW butter and other soy butter products are not permitted. If your child has an allergy, please let the classroom teacher know as soon as possible to ensure everyone's safety. PLEASE remember we are a SCENT-FREE SCHOOL.

School Lunch

The School Lunch Association aims to serve students a hot, nutritious lunch regardless of a family's financial situation. Families can sign up for this service online. Every year, registration do that for you.

Bus Route Information: Rennie's River <u>Current bus runs and routes</u>. Please ensure you know the time and bus stop assigned for your child before the first day of school.

Please take time over the weekend to familiarize yourself with the route information in preparation for next week. Bus routes are also posted to our website. Please note that seats are not assigned on this portal. Students will be given a seat number on the first day of school and are expected to use that assigned seat for the remainder of the year.

Outside Play

The staff at Rennie's River are committed to incorporating outside play as often as possible. We will be having outdoor lunch playtime for Grade 1-6 students as often as the weather permits. Kindergarten -Grade 3 students will also spend scheduled time outdoors as their includes programming play-based learning. We believe a large part of learning is engaging in exploration, adventure, and play while enjoying the fresh air of the outdoors! To help this run smoothly, please ensure your child is dressed for the weather every day! It is helpful for children, especially those in the primary grades, to have a change of clothes in their locker (shirt, pants, socks, underwear) in case they get wet or dirty.


Parking Lot Safety



A reminder to our school community that our parking lot continues to follow a **one way direction** of traffic flow. Our kiss and ride stop is located on the top of the stairs to the playground (Blue heart). Parents/Guardians are asked to use this location only as a drop off point for their child in the morning. Once drop off has taken place, vehicles are then to proceed in a one directional flow toward Elizabeth Avenue or in a one directional flow around our parking lot (see red and green arrows). A reminder that vehicles are not permitted to stop near our student entrance for drop off purposes. A yellow area highlighted and marked 'AM' shows where the bus drops off our students in the morning. A map has been included for your reference. This picture shows where the buses will be parked in the afternoon. Parents are encouraged to be mindful of their speed when entering and exiting our parking lot and to ensure that they are not passing our buses. Thank you for your assistance and for working with us to ensure the safety of our students.
