Each group is working concurrently to solve the puzzle. Read the story to the class. Before they begin, each group must pick up two hint cards, and the first clue. Start the timer! Differentiation: If you only have one set of Breakout boxes, get each group to do half the challenges, bearing in mind that this will change how long it take to complete the challenge. For larger classes, divide into 4 groups and have		

	each group complete half the challenges (only possible with two Breakout box sets).	
Tools and Tech Required See Instructions: https://goo.gl/IHFv3t	You do: (30 minutes) Students work together to solve the clues and try to open the Breakout Box before the timer runs out. Some clues will be fairly easy and straightforward, others will require some thought and collaboration to solve. Groups have two Hint cards they can use. Otherwise they have to complete the task relying only on their group members for help.

You do: (20 minutes) Students will answer the journal questions in a Doc file and submit their responses to the Journal/Portfolio Google Classroom.
