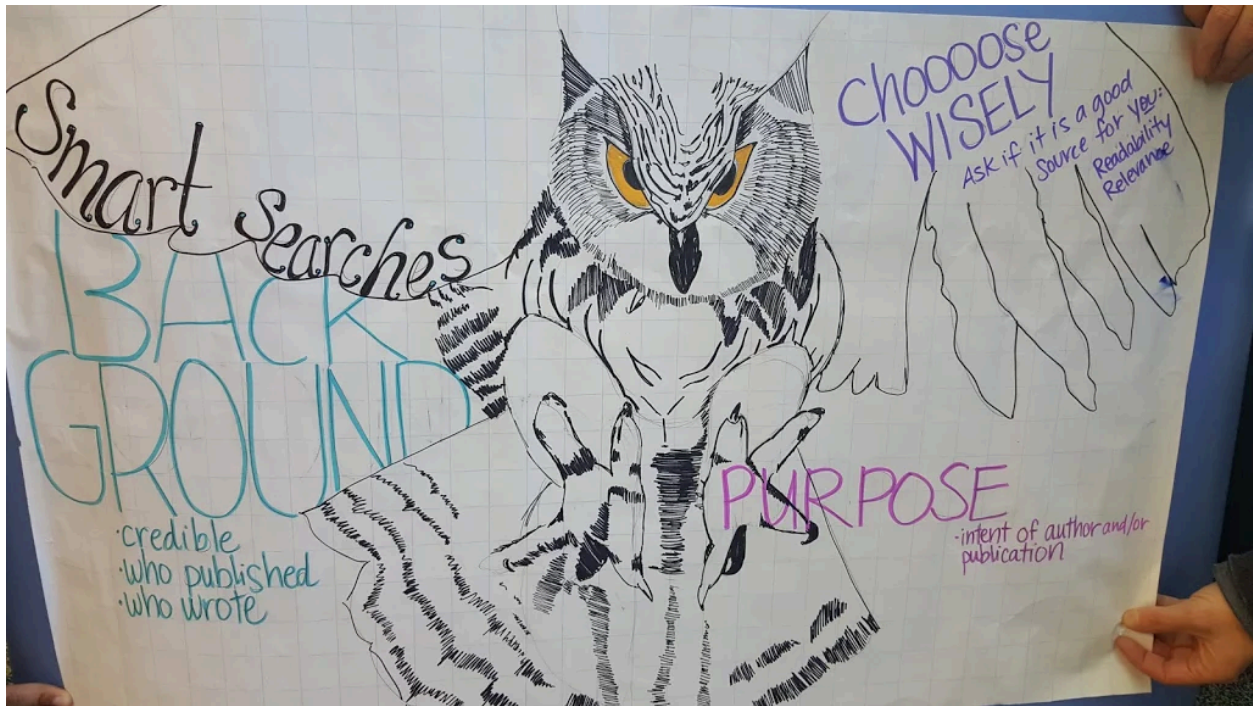


# SMART SEARCHING



Three things to consider when [searching](#):

## CHOOOOSE WISELY

- What is your own reading level?
- What is the relevance of the article to your topic?

What is the **BACKGROUND** of the article?

- Who published the article
- Who wrote the article- how are they qualified?

Identify the **PURPOSE** of the article

- Is there obvious bias?
- Is there an intent and/ or agenda for the publisher?
