

Summary of Quotes for STC Wrestling Rooms

Resilite Quote- Total = \$104,883.58 + Wall Mat Installation - \$6,450

Advantages - Resilite is a very reputable company in the world of wrestling mats. They are the only company that makes a traditional mat which is the safest and most durable mat that is double sided allowing for longevity. The practice mats come in 2 sections that allows for less taping. The competition mat is a patented zip technology that also eliminates the cost of taping for meets. Mat tape runs anywhere from \$12-\$16 a roll. We spent \$2200 this past school year on mat tape. Sent a rep to the school to meet with admin and coaches to ensure satisfaction. Professional installation of wall mats and underlayment. Competition mat is similar in pricing to the other companies.

Disadvantages - The cost of shipping is considerably more expensive. I'm assuming this has to do with weight as the traditional mats are much heavier. Overall cost is higher. Additional cost of Installation of the wall mats.

Dollamur Quote - Total = \$70,106.20

Advantages - Could provide aesthetically the same type of look we are going for similar to Resilite. Cost of the project and shipping is cheaper. Use a velcro style to connect mats eliminating the need for tape. Mat tape runs anywhere from \$12-\$16 a roll. We spent \$2200 this past school year on mat tape

Disadvantages - The practice mats would not be traditional mats that have more cushioning and durability. The mats are not double sided and would have less longevity. I'm not confident that the velcro would work much past the 5 year warranty and then we would have to tape 10 seams in each practice room adding that cost on. We will have to install everything.

EZ Flex - Total = \$61,842.62 without tax.

Advantages - Cost and shipping will be cheaper. Very similar to Dollamur in what is being offered. Offer a rolled wall mat that provides a seamless appearance. Not sure what the top would look like of the wall mats.

Disadvantages - Lightweight mats similar to Dollamur for the practice room. Not double sided or as soft and durable. They do not offer velcro or zipper style seams, and must use tape, cost of tape is listed above. We will have to install everything. They do not offer underlayment underneath the mat. Would have to go with a different company for that.

Coach and Administration Recommendations -

Unanimously we feel the traditional mat is the way to go for the practice room for athlete safety and longevity of the mat and why we would recommend going with Resilite. The current practice room traditional mat has lasted a good 20 years both as a competition mat and a practice mat. We also feel they provide the best product for wall mats that will be long lasting and serve its purpose of keeping athletes safe. Those are the biggest reasons for going with Resilite.
