


# Log-In to District Curriculum from a Home Computer

1. Visit our school or district website: [www.laveenschools.org](http://www.laveenschools.org)
2. Click on Students → Then the site you would like to log in to.



3. Click Log In with Google and sign in with your district provided account that ends in [@stu.laveeneld.org](mailto:@stu.laveeneld.org) (this is the same account students use to log-in to chromebooks at school with the [@stu.laveeneld.org](mailto:@stu.laveeneld.org) added).
