

We can make a tangible difference to campus life/the Whitman College experience via sexual assault prevention.

- Working with Admission Office on early decision group: processing thirty <u>I-20 forms</u>; there will be approximately 50-60 admitted students to process. ISS have a yield rate of 30%, UWC

Scholars 60%; students from China 10%-15%. These are students who have been admitted and paid deposit (some receive waiver from deposit); some students won't ultimate attend Whitman (won't be able to obtain a visa, etc.).

- Office of Religious and Spiritual Life

- Continuing to work with students in crisis and much work pertaining to RSL groups.
- Ramadan in April (Saturday 2 April Monday 2 May, 2022). Would like to bring Tricities Imam to campus a couple of times this semester to support the Muslim community.
- Hillel will host annual Seder for approximately 90 people (first night of Passover is Friday, April 15 and continues until Saturday, April 23).
- Whitman College South Asian Students Association will participate in the traditional Hindu celebration of Holi – the Festival of Spring / Colors / Love (this year's global observance being March 18, 2022).
- Unitarian Universalist flower commune in April. Small religious ceremony, but among the most important and meaningful.

- Inclusion Fellows Spring 2022 John conducted initial meeting with the IC Fellows on 2/18; discussed concept of zone approximal development with regards to the programs and events that they may be considering for the semester, i.e. do they have support / will they need support, and in the absence of Intercultural Center Director, will they maybe need to reconsider and recalibrate? John reiterated that he can assist them with seeking out campus and community resources, but they may need to view their programming through the lens of self-sustainability. What can they accomplish by themselves, without an IC Director to provide direct support?
- Weekly One-On-One Meetings with VPDI Inclusion Fellows Aziz Sahbazovic '24 (LGBTQIA+),
 Lydia Moriku '24 (Belonging & Support), Tatiana Villegas '23 (First-Generation & Mentoring), and
 Marina Balasanyan '24 (Creative Projects), will be meeting with John weekly. Meetings are now set for
 the semester with Lydia and Tatiana, meeting set with Aziz this week (and Natasha will work with Aziz
 to set recurring date/time); no response from Marina as of yet (Natasha will follow-up).
- **Search for Interim Intercultural Center Director** Securing Interim Director may not be the best avenue to pursue at this juncture; After initial contact/discussion, John's two referred leads did not follow through. He is working on revisions for IC Director job posting and we are hoping to move forward with next steps in the national search for a new Director within the next week or two.

International Student and Scholar Services

- Administrative Updates Greg is currently undertaking SEVIS registration (or 'check-in') process, which he runs early each semester. Having reached Census Day (class enrollment confirmed and completed), he gathers the following information from various sources:
 - Class enrollment info from registrar office. I need to review the number of credits and changes to majors
 - On campus housing
 - Off campus housing and phone numbers
 - Health insurance verification
 - Study abroad list

He brings all of this together using numerous EXCEL formulas and Access queries that he builds and uses the resulting data to update each individual record in the SEVIS (Student and Exchange Visitor Information System) federal database.

- ISS Admissions Enrollment and Looking Ahead to 2022-2023 85 ISS student applications were
 processed in 2021-2022; 65 students came to campus (in addition to the 12 sophomores arriving on
 campus for the first time). John stated that Greg has Division support to communicate to Admissions
 how many students he can/would like to accommodate, i.e. 40/45-50. He can set the number and
 establish capacity so that he and his program mitigate the risk of being oversaturated.
- Outdoor Field Trips Participation International students participating in college-led outdoor trips: a snowshoe orientation at Tollgate, and upcoming outdoor field trip for 10 international students.
 Students receive \$75.00 per semester (BCOF fund) for event/field trip participation, which covers approximately two outings.
- 2022 International Graduates Greg is currently undertaking numerous tax sessions with students who will be graduating this semester.
- Food Pantry GAC received Walmart delivery of food pantry items yesterday; supply chain issues rendering some items unavailable.

Office of Religious and Spiritual Life

- Potential Hate Crime / Islamophobic Incident Adam had a conversation with a small group of Muslim students regarding Islamic discriminatory graffiti that appeared on campus last semested, and is also in contact with Muslim leadership about this.
- RSL Programming Adam provided an overview of semester events that are back up-and-running this week (Grieving@Whitman on Mondays, Big Tent on Wednesdays, Spirituali-TEA on Fridays). Other potential events between now and the end of the academic year:
