

SST4 Training Opportunity - Safety Assessment and Intervention Training (SAI)

The Ohio Department of Education is working with [Sandy Hook Promise](#) as part of a **three-year** STOP School Violence Act Grant sponsored by the Department of Justice. The grant permits Safety Assessment and Intervention (SAI) training to over 3,000 schools in Ohio. This national evidenced-based training was developed by Dr. Dewey G. Cornell from the University of Virginia.

Safety Assessment and Intervention Training (SAI) training is a 1-day training designed to train multi-disciplinary teams (ex. superintendents, principals, safety/security, counselors, and school psychologists) in:

- identifying threats, signs, and behaviors that may lead to violent acts.
- determining the seriousness of a threat.
- developing intervention plans that protect potential victims.
- addressing the underlying problem that initiated the conflict.
- engaging student clubs known as SAVE promise clubs.
