I. Governor Lucie Nguyen entertains a motion to amend the following:

- A. Article 4: Judging, Section 3 of the District Code of Contests & Awards from “Out of the 100-400 possible points to earn for every award, if no application accumulates more than a total of 60% of all earnable points or earns more than 90% for the distinguished officer awards, then the highest earning application will receive a certificate and be featured as an honorable mention on the Texas-Oklahoma CKI website for that CKI year.”

B.

Article 4: Judging

Section 1: Unless noted otherwise, The District Board of Officers, or other designated party, shall judge all awards. This is highlighted under the Texas-Oklahoma District Policy Code Article XIII, Section 4.

Section 2: Judges shall not judge in any contest in which their home club or alma mater is entered, unless extenuating circumstances exist and the board is majority from the school in which awards were entered. The primary judge would have to be a District Board Member or other approved judge with no University affiliation to the applying club.

Section 3: Out of the 100-150 ~~100-400~~ possible points to earn for every award, the highest scoring club or individual will receive the award. ~~if no application accumulates more than a total of 60% of all earnable points or earns more than~~ For distinguished officer awards, recipients must receive 90%, otherwise ~~for the distinguished officer awards, then~~ the highest earning application will receive a certificate and be featured as an honorable mention on the Texas-Oklahoma CKI website for that CKI year.

Section 4: The recipient for each District Award shall be the applicant or nominee designated in the highest scoring application unless stated otherwise in the award in question's respective section of the District Code of Contests & Awards.

Section 5: The decisions of the judges are final. No changes, alterations, or re-grading will take place after the results have been certified by the judges and the District Administrators.

Section 6: In the event that there is a tie on any award, all applications that accumulated the same number of points yet also received the highest total points earned will receive the award.
