About Impact Health Collective India (IHCI)

Impact Health Collective India (IHCI) is a fictional nonprofit created for training purposes. IHCI runs free, community-based health camps in underserved neighborhoods across Bengaluru, Mumbai, Kolkata, and Delhi. Our goal is to help people access basic screening, trusted referrals, and follow-up support.

What services do health camps provide?

- Basic health screening (BP, BMI, blood sugar spot check when available)
- Maternal health counseling and referral guidance
- Child nutrition screening and counseling
- Health education (hygiene, diabetes awareness, anemia awareness)
- Referrals to partner clinics for cases needing additional care

Who can attend?

Anyone in the community can attend. We prioritize outreach to women, children, elderly residents, and people who have limited access to routine check-ups. Services are free.

Cost

All camps are free of charge. We never charge beneficiaries for screening or counseling.

How do people find out about camps?

- WhatsApp community groups
- Posters on notice boards (schools, clinics, community centers)
- Local community leaders
- Anganwadi and ASHA worker referrals

Registration and attendance

- Walk-in is always allowed.
- If pre-registration is offered, it is only for planning (not required).

- Arrive early to reduce waiting time.

What should participants bring?

- Any existing medical records (if they have them)
- A list of current medicines (name + dosage), if applicable
- Any ID document if available (optional; see eligibility policy for details)

Languages

Camps are supported in Hindi and English. In some locations, Bengali support is available.

Where and when are camps held?

Camps are scheduled monthly in each city. Typical duration is 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM. Exact location and timing are announced via WhatsApp and posters at least 5 days in advance.

Data privacy and consent (high level)

- We collect only the minimum information needed to provide services and follow-up.
- We do not share personal information publicly.
- Beneficiaries can opt out of follow-up at any time.
