

How to Write a "Showing the Knowing" Reflection

This category is where you **capture the process of learning** and your thinking as you are learning about something or developing a new skill. **You are TEACHING someone a skill or knowledge you have learned.**

Examples of "Showing the Knowing" Posts:

- A video with you narrating your thinking (out loud) as you solve a math problem.
- A video where you are fixing a run on sentence in your writing and talking about how you are fixing it.
- A video where you are replacing weak words with powerful words in your writing and explaining how it improves the meaning and writer's voice.
- A video where you are explaining how a scientific concept connects to something in real life.
- A video capture of something you did in integrated studies where you are explaining the process and results.

STEP ONE: Plan the Teaching
