

New Roma Beta Notes (for front page and/or other documentation)

What is it

Roma is an ODD Editor, using the TEI ODD (One Document Does-it-all) format for meta-schema documentation and local encoding guidelines as created by the [Text Encoding Initiative](#).

What it is supposed to do

Roma enables you to create a customisation of a larger scheme such as the TEI. It provides a user-friendly interface to pick and choose Elements, Attribute Classes, Model Classes, and Datatypes used in a schema. For each element the documentation, attributes, class memberships and content models are able to be modified. You may start from a previously saved ODD customisation or load one of the pre-defined templates as a starting point.

What it doesn't do

The conversions of the ODD customisation to other formats (both schemas and documentation formats) is handled by passing the document to the TEI-C's Oxgarage service. In addition there are a number of tasks that this version of Roma does not handle.
