- Mandatory Racism Classes
 - Doesn't directly affect grad students, but high impact to administrations
 - All undergrads here are International and Cultural Diversity (ICD) courses
 6 hours
 - In order to be ICD, no process and rubric, just needs to be approved by faculty senate
 - Split ICD credit hours to 2: half will be "old" module, half for Communicating Diversity? (CD) for how to communicate difficult dialogue (racism-related) module
 - Module focused on experiential experiences
 - Rubric not finalized but was presented to Faculty Senate for review
 - Anti-racism course will also be mandatory in Fall 2019, must be satisfied to graduate
- Each One Tell One Campaign
 - Will be done with MarComm
 - Tell them two things: 1) step in (bystanders), 2) victims
 - Collect CLEAR game day bags and give to another person
 - Ask Alisha for new swag
