They should be centered, with captions included below them. Ensure that the resolution is adequate for clear viewing.**

All subsequent paragraphs are set with no indent but justified. This section should include the contextualization, the significance and impact of your presentation on the conference subject/topic.

METHODOLOGY

All paragraphs are set with no indent but justified. This section should describe the crucial aspects of the material and methods.

RESULTS AND CONCLUSIONS

All paragraphs are set with no indent but justified. This section should highlight the main findings of the research, a brief discussion and conclusions.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

All paragraphs are set with no indent but justified. This section expresses gratitude to contributors who assisted in the research but are not authors.

REFERENCES

All paragraphs are set with no indent but justified. This section provides a list of all sources cited in the article with full citation details. References should follow APA style. Please ensure consistency in citation format, including author names, publication years, titles, and journal names
