
Bills Lose In London

Injuries and penalties were the story of the **Buffalo Bills** 25-20 loss this morning to the **Jacksonville Jaguars**. After a slow start on offense the team was unable to show any sign of life in the first half. Not passing the 50 yard line until 4 minutes left in the half Buffalo did not look like the Bills of years past.



Even with the injuries on defense and 100 yards in penalties they were able to keep the Jaguars offense in check. Von Miller also made his season debut today but was on a limited snap count. Prior to the game fans were confident; one saying "Josh is going to go off against this defense". But they didn't get to see the Josh Allen from the first 4 weeks until late in the 4th quarter which ended up being too little too late. Josh Allen ended the day 27/40 for 359 yards, 2 passing touchdowns and 1 rushing touchdown. He also had 1 interception on the day. The game ended with a **Stefon** Diggs fumble with 13 seconds left on the clock. This was following an attempted comeback for the Bills who were able to score 13 points in the last 4 minutes, but they also gave up a touchdown in between so it was not enough to get the win.
