EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN – Don Christian Park

Location

The event is situated at Don Christian Park at **184 Street and 62nd Avenue** in Surrey, BC.

EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT LOCATIONS

- AED LOCATION – No AED on site.
 - FIRST AID – TEAMS REQUIRED TO HAVE BASIC FIRST AID KITS OF THEIR OWN
 - Don Christian Recreation Center - Monday to Friday: 8:30am to 4:30pm. Closed on weekends.
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Emergency Vehicle Entrances and Egress to Park and Parking

- Parking 1 and Gate Access– 184 street at 62 Ave BLK (Lot located at the Don Christian Recreation Center. Enter off of 184 St. Gate)
 - Gate Access 1 – 186 street at 62 A Ave BLK (Street access to grass fields but no parking)

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CHARGE PERSON RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Conduct an initial assessment of the injury.
2. Designate someone to watch the other participants (stop all activities and ensure all participants are in a safe area if nobody is available to supervise).
3. Wait with the injured participant and help keep them calm until emergency medical services arrive and conduct their assessment of the injury.
4. Record the injury using their club's accident report form.

CALL PERSON RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Call for emergency help.
2. Provide all necessary information to dispatch.
 - The facility location
 - The closest access door to the injured participant
 - The nature of the injury
 - A description of first aid that has been performed
 - Other medical information, such as allergies or medical conditions
3. Clear any traffic from the facility entrance or access road before the ambulance arrives.
4. Wait by the entrance to direct the ambulance.
5. Call the participant's emergency contact person.
6. Assist the charge person as needed.
