

Tŷ Ni Accessibility

Location and entrance

Tŷ Ni is located at 12a Pearl Place, above a working garage. Access to the building is through a blue metal gate with a small step, followed by an outdoor metal staircase of 12 steps to the right of the garage that leads up one storey. The staircase has a handrail and motion-sensor lighting. As it is uncovered, it may become slippery during wet weather.

Parking and bicycles

There is no designated parking available at the venue. Bicycles can be locked to the railings opposite the space, where there is empty land. Bikes must not be locked inside the blue gate while the garage is operating, as this may restrict their work and could result in damage to bikes as vehicles enter and exit.

Indoor Entrance - Kitchen and bathroom access

The kitchen is the first space on entry, and the toilet is on the same level. Kitchen counters are standard height, with most items stored on or below the counters, although some items such as the fridge and shelving are positioned higher. The bathroom is a large unisex space with a toilet and sink. A shower is present but is not currently usable. Both the kitchen and bathroom are lit by overhead lighting only.

Main event space and comfort area

Access to the main event space from the kitchen requires climbing five wooden steps. The space includes desks and chairs, two large sofas, some armchairs, and several smaller tables. Lighting options include overhead lighting, lower-light options, and ceiling fairy lights. A further half-storey staircase of seven steps leads to a small mezzanine area, which is designated as a comfort area for those needing a break from the crowd. This area is not separated by walls, so sound from the main event space may still be audible.

Outdoor veranda

From the main event space, there is access to an outdoor veranda via a small step. This area is uncovered and includes seating. It overlooks the railway, and smoking is permitted in this space only. Due to nearby residential neighbours, attendees are asked to keep noise levels low when using the veranda, particularly in the evening.

Wheelchair user consideration

As the venue includes stairs, it is unfortunately not wheelchair accessible. If you require assistance using stairs, the organiser can arrange volunteer support; however, wheelchair access is not possible at this venue.

Noise considerations

As the venue is located next to a railway line, occasional train noise may be heard. This noise is minimal indoors. The veranda is directly connected to the event space and is encouraged for use as a quieter, low-stimulation area.

Animals

Service animals are welcome at Tŷ Ni. No other animals are permitted.
