At the time of creating this document, our plan was not to charge admission for the tournament. We thank in advance our generous sponsors and volunteers for their support.

Officials

The tournament officials are supplied and assigned through the cooperation of the Alberta Volleyball Officials Association.

- Minor officials are students and community members so please treat them all with respect as they are volunteering their time to make this as special a tournament as possible.

Protests

As per ASAA policy, a grievance committee has been organized to handle discipline and appeals. The committee will have the authority to address issues of a serious nature that may occur before, during or after a Provincial Championship match, or to hear appeals of the automatic suspension resulting from an ejection (see ASAA 2023/24 Policy Handbook). The committee may include, but not limited to, the tournament chairperson, an official and two coaches not in conflict with the issue. Coaches wishing to volunteer may do so at the coaches meeting. All grievances will be referred to the Tournament Chair who will in turn make a presentation to the Grievance Committee. The decision of this committee is final and not subject to appeal.

ASAA Policies

Coaches are reminded to make themselves aware of the ASAA policy with respect to drugs, alcohol, and tobacco, and the policy referring to teacher supervision.

Team Hosts

Each team will be assigned a host for the duration of the tournament. There duties include but not limited to:

- Lead each team into the gym for Opening Ceremonies
- Act as the team's tour guide and liaison to St. Jerome School
- Be nearby to cheer and support their team.

Sportsmanship:

A selection committee, including a representative from the officials, will choose the winner of the Sportsmanship Plaque. The presentation of the plaque will be made at the recipient's school at a later date.

Throughout the tournament, the selection committee will also recognize individuals with sportsmanship pins & keychains. These pins may be given to players, coaches, parents and spectators who exhibit outstanding displays of integrity, fair play and good sportsmanship.

Live Streaming


Games from both St. Jerome and JR Robson will be livestreamed through Hudl. The link will be found on the host website and there is a fee of:

The Christmas parade starts at 6:00 on mainstreet Vermilion. A map can be found on the Vermilion Chamber of Commerce website.


