

Have you ever thought about becoming a skilled gardener? Flowers have been a symbol of beauty and emotions for thousands of years, and to grow beautiful flowers, we need to understand the basic process of planting. My name is Stella, and in this short video, I will explain the main steps for planting flowers.

Step one is to choose the flower seeds. Different types of flowers have different suitable growing environments. When selecting flower seeds, you need to know the characteristics of the place where you plan to plant them. In this video, I will use roses as the main representative since they are my favourite flower.

Step two, in addition to rose seedlings, you will need some other gardening tools such as pruning shears, flower fertilizer, a shovel, a watering can, new soil, and gardening gloves.

Step three, choose the planting location. The location should ideally receive at least six hours of sunlight every day, with few other weeds nearby, and the soil should be soft and fertile.

Step five, transplant the seedlings. Place them into the pre-dug holes and fill the soil back in, ensuring that the soil around the roots is firm. You can use your hands to remove any air pockets.

Step six, give the seedlings enough nutrients by adding flower fertilizer and covering the topsoil with a layer of new soil. This will help keep the seedlings warm.

Step seven, water the seedlings regularly. Healthy roses need a lot of water, typically two to three times per week.

Step eight, prune the leaves and branches. Pruning can help flower bushes maintain their beauty and health. Prune areas with too many leaves or branches to prevent rotting or disease, remember cutting them at a 45-degree angle.

Finally, which is the Step nine, when the roses are fully grown, consider planting more varieties of flowers. By next spring, you will have a beautiful garden to enjoy.
