Athletic Eligibility Requirements (from CMS Handbook)

Students will abide by the participation in extracurricular policy as adopted by the RSU 87 school board. As reflected in that policy, academic achievement, habits of learning, attendance and appropriate student conduct are necessary in order to be eligible for participation. Athletes are expected to commit to all practices (within reason) and games. In an effort to better prepare our students to compete at the high school level and to better align our expectations with the Maine Principal Associations *Bona Fide Team Rule*, in the event that a student is on multiple teams beyond their commitment to Caravel, Caravel's teams take first priority if and when a scheduling conflict arises.
