Crews worked to remove old broken parts for the playset at Lydic Park. This was coordinated so that our Crews would remove these parts just as the Repairs were to be made, Also 200 yards of mulch were distributed and to say the least this is a large task to spread. We had two of our loaders out of service for some days which put us behind schedule.

Mowing is top priority for May. The grass grows so fast. Dog Park was sprayed for weed/Grass around the fencing. Again we sourced high concentrated vinegar and not herbicides for this area.

Our Crews worked to have the ball fields in great condition for the start of the Tball season. The Recreation Director was very happy with our results this year.

The fishing derby was held. We had 30 children under 14 who came to fish.

Flags were put up for Memorial Day, the Village dump truck was waxed and prepared for its Parade Duties.
