Preliminary considerations

If you are a resident in another parish, the preparation will be done at your own parish. Please note that we will also need a letter from your own Pastor giving you permission to get married in our Parish. This is required by Church Law.

Who can get married at St. Peter's Church or Our Lady of Victory Church ?

Priority is given to the parishioners of St Peter's Church and Our Lady of Victory in arranging a date for a wedding. Subject to availability, we will accommodate non-parishioners if the requested wedding date is available. For non-parishioners, you will need permission from your own Pastor to be married at our Church. The wedding preparation will be completed in your own Parish with your own Pastor.

St. Peter's Church is located at 22 Barclay Street.

Our Lady of Victory is located at 60 Williams Street

ARRANGING A DATE

Arrangements should be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance of your proposed wedding date. The couple should arrange to meet with the Pastor, **Fr. Jarlath Quinn**, to arrange a date and to record it in the Parish Calendar.

PRE-MARRIAGE COURSE - Pre Cana

The Archdiocese of New York requires that all engaged couples complete an approved pre-marriage preparation program. Together with the conferences with the clergy of the parish, the Pre-Cana course is an integral part of the preparation for marriage. Couples should take special care in selecting the course and the various options available. WEDDING DOCUMENTATION AND CHECKLIST

- Current Copy of your Baptism Certificate

You will need to contact the Church where you were baptized to obtain this current certificate with the details of the Sacraments that you have received since your baptism. It has to be dated within 6 months at most prior to your wedding date.

- Sign up for Pre-Cana program

- Complete the [Pre Nuptial Investigation form](#)

The priest will review the completed document at your second appointment.

- Obtain a Marriage License

Available from any town hall and valid for sixty days.

FEES

- The current church donation (July 1st, 2025) is \$3,000.

- A \$750 deposit payable on [Parish Giving](#) at the first appointment with Fr. Quinn.

Punctuality

Please be on time for the rehearsal and the wedding itself. We schedule our parish events on the understanding that you will be punctual. Please be aware that other events, including weddings, may be planned before and/or after your rehearsal or wedding.

Safety

Using paper runners, throwing rice, rose petals, confetti, etc. or releasing balloons, butterflies or doves is strictly prohibited. These are safety and aesthetic concerns and expose potential insurance liability issues for you and your guests. We thank you, in advance, for your cooperation
