The Wisconsin Volleyball Conference is excited to announce the **2019 WVC Alumni Scholarship Competition!** After a year-long fundraising campaign, the Alumni Scholarship Committee is now accepting applications for this year's competition. The WVC Alumni Scholarship recipient will be announced at this year's WVC Championships.

A main goal of the WVC was to build a credible, varsity-like experience for college athletes who would never have the opportunity to play NCAA sanctioned volleyball. While it didn't happen overnight, it's safe to say that the WVC has accomplished this goal. When considering our league's legacy and how we continue to strive for credibility, a scholarship seemed like a perfect way to leave a lasting impact. Thus, the concept of the WVC Alumni Scholarship Fund was born. Who is Eligible?

The WVC Alumni Scholarship is awarded to individuals in their second, third or fourth year (returning for their 5th year) of college and are currently competing on a WVC member team. Nominees must demonstrate financial need as well as a deep appreciation and understanding of the mission of intercollegiate club volleyball. In addition, they need to provide evidence of being a good teammate as well as their collegiate and career goals.

How do I apply?

Applicants must complete the [WVC Scholarship Application](#) by **Tuesday, April 2, 2019, at 11:59 pm**

The form includes four parts:

Part 1 - **Personal Information**

Part 2 - **Video Interview Response** (2 questions to be recorded in a short video)

Part 3 - **Short Answer Questions** (6)

Part 4 - **One Letter of Recommendation** from a University Representative OR a current teammate (not a coach).

The scholarship payment(s) will be distributed upon the recipient providing proof of enrollment in a WVC member school for the 2019 Fall Semester.

How much will be awarded?

\$1,000.00

Selection Process

The WVC Alumni Scholarship Committee will meet on Wednesday, April 3 to review applications and determine the scholarship award winner(s).
