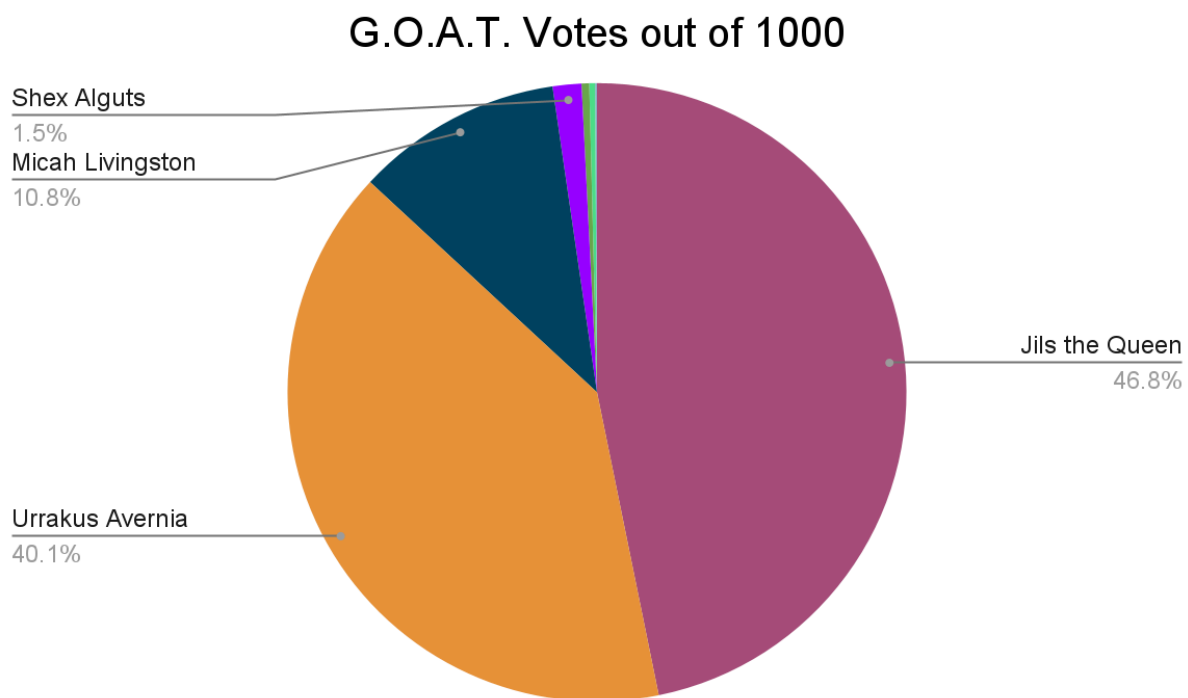


The 101 AL Champion Challenge G.O.A.T. Survey

Methodology

This survey was conducted by a random selection of 1000 Nornians. All cities and demographics were represented.¹ Ages represented range from 3-742. Participants were given an online form with two questions: “Who is the greatest Champion of all time?” and “Why?”. Respondents cited factors such as longevity, dominance over competitors, ingenuity in challenge design, and overall cultural impact.

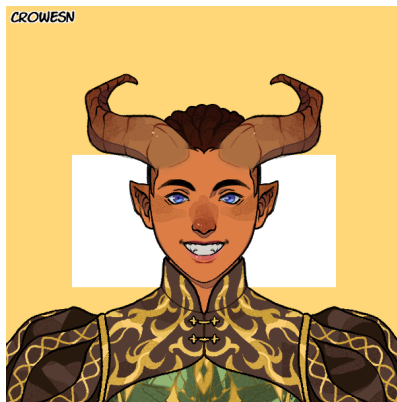
Micah Livingston



Micah Livingston was the Champion of Varmitville from 11-26 AL. Known for his cocky demeanor and brash personality, it has become difficult to separate

the genuine stories of his exploits from urban legends that fans fabricated or exaggerated. The monk often toyed with opponents, drawing out fights to gain favor from the audience. If you believe everything you hear, he would intentionally get hit by fireballs and eldritch blasts just to give his foes a fighting chance. However, the Champion Challenge has become much more specialized over time, with challengers devoting their entire lives to the challenge instead of having other careers. Thus, people often write Micah off due to his era, saying he competed against firefighters and plumbers.

Urrakus Avernia



Urrakus Avernia holds the record for most years spent as a Champion. He was in charge of Liquicada from 68-87 AL. A paladin with a mighty spear that could teleport back into his hand, Urrakus was the perfect trifecta of speed, strength, and smarts on the battlefield. Early in his career, he was known as a rich and spoiled playboy, but following a near defeat in 74 AL, the Champion cleaned up his act and became a pillar in the community. After his defeat in 87, Urrakus announced his retirement. However, he returned in 92 and became the

Charborough Champion for 15 months, bringing his total time as a Champion past 20 years. In his middle age, Avernia did not have the same explosive power as before and had to win with wiles and experience. Some fans believe this tarnished his image as an athletic marvel, while others point out it showcased his full skillset, if only for a short time. Urrakus still lives in Liquicada and often attends public events to help raise funds for causes near and dear to his heart.

Jils the Queen



Jils Boer was born in Paradeisos to a poor farming family. Her rise to Champion status has been chronicled in many biographies, but the most repeated fact is that she became the Champion of Molvomor on her very first attempt despite being the only Challenger to make it to the second round. She was Champion from 54-65 AL, and for the first ten years of her reign no one even came close to beating her. The triton warlock never revealed who or what her pact was made with, but she was able to summon barnacle-encrusted chains from the earth to restrain and flay her enemies. This dominance earned her the nickname “The Queen”, as the public deemed her more powerful and

commanding than one of the Lords themselves. Sadly, tragedy struck in 65 AL. A mysterious medical episode reduced Jils to a shell of her former self; she seemed physically unharmed but was withdrawn and could hardly muster a psychic lance. She was swiftly defeated and withdrew from the public eye. Despite this career-ending event, Jils remains the biggest “What If?” in Champion Challenge history and despite holding Champion status for barely over half of Urrakus’ record, she comes out on top once more in the annual G.O.A.T. survey.
