Dear Parents & Guardians,

CONGRATULATIONS! Your child has been chosen as a class representative for the 2024-2025 Coronation event. This year's theme is "In Our Rocket Era" and will be held on Saturday, February 22, 2025 at 2:00 pm in the Junior High Cafetorium. Coronation is a long-standing tradition in Robinson ISD and is currently the top fundraiser for the Robinson Education Foundation who has provided about half a million dollars in teacher grants.

The Robinson Education Foundation is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization governed by a board of directors who support two programs in Robinson ISD: teacher grants and Celebration of Stars. **Please read carefully** as Coronation has changed over the years.

Each class chose a boy and girl class representative that will **individually** have a chance at competing for Duke and Duchess of their grade in PK-6 while grades 7-12 chose one couple per house per campus. Your child has been chosen as a class representative and has **two options for participation**. They can:

**1. Not raise funds and just serve as the class representative.**

**This includes:**

- Having their picture taken on a designated day on campus
- Inclusion in the video as class rep and part of grade level court

**This does NOT include**

- Attending the coronation event or being able to compete against the other class reps for the title of Duke/Duchess, Prince/Princess, or Coronation King/Queen

**2. Sell raffle tickets (all online this year) to raise funds and attend/compete in Coronation.**

**This includes:**

- **Every student who raises \$500 in raffle sales will participate in the coronation day event on Saturday, February 22, 2025.**
- Competing for titles of Duke/Duchess for the grade level and Prince/Princess for the campus as well as Coronation King and Queen
- Each child that raises \$500 in raffle tickets, will participate in Coronation by being announced on stage.
- Tickets for the Coronation day event are: General admission \$10 each, reserved seating at a table \$25 each or \$200 per table. (There are a limited number of reserved seats.)
- **Please note:** There will not be couples this year, so there is no need to coordinate any dress prior to the event if your child sells \$500. Students will not be paired up as a "couple" until the announcement of Duke/Duchess for each grade. If you would like for your child to have a boutonniere/corsage, you may purchase that for your own individual child.

### **Raffle Ticket Information:**

Students who wish to participate in Coronation on Feb. 22nd **only need to sell raffle tickets and nothing else.** To participate in the event, your student **must sell at least \$500 in raffle tickets.** Raffle tickets are \$5 each.

Raffle tickets are all online this year. Student pages will be set up for them and each student will have their own page to sell raffle tickets. Individual student pages may be customized with a picture and information about the student. You will receive a link for your child's individual page by January 20, 2025. **Raffle ticket sales are from January 24th at 7:00 am thru February 7th at 6:59 pm CST.** Raffle winners will be announced at Coronation and posted on social media at the conclusion of the event (first name drawn, second name drawn, etc.).
