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1. Introduction

Briefly introduce the context and importance of the work, highlighting its novelty or relevance. State the objectives clearly.. Highlight the significance of the review in advancing the field. The manuscript should be no longer than 3000-6000 words, and the combined figures and tables should not exceed 10. The manuscript should be prepared in a single column, single-spaced, with sufficient margins (2 cm) for editorial and proofreader's marks. 12 pt Cal. font should be used throughout, and all pages should be numbered consecutively. The introduction consists of background and objective. Use APA 7 for citations and references.

Present the essential findings or insights in a structured and concise manner. Use tables, figures, or diagrams where appropriate to summarize results. Include a brief interpretation of the findings and their significance. Equations should be placed at the center of the line. The use of Microsoft Equation Editor or MathType is preferred.

Tables and figures must be mentioned in sentences; using the international System of Units (SI). The table uses Cal letters. 10 follows the following format:

Citations of published literature in the text should be given in the APA (American Psychological Association) 7 Style. Use EndNote, Mendeley, or Zotero for management and formatting. The sources cited in the text must be listed alphabetically in the reference list and vice versa. To insert a citation in the text, include the author's surname and year of publication.

One author : (Field, 2005) or Field (2005)

Two authors : (Gass & Varonis, 1984) or Gass and Varonis (1984)

Three and more : (Tremblay et al., 2010) or Tremblay et al. (2010)

To cite two or more works together, arrange the in-text citations alphabetically in the same order in which they appear in the reference list. The following examples of citations include more than one work in the same parenthesis.

Use an international journal and proceed only as references, APA 7 style. At least 50% of references do not exceed five years of publication, are relevant, and 10% self-citation is allowed. The minimum number of references is 30 manuscripts (original research), 60 manuscripts (review), and 25 manuscripts (Case Report and Short Communication). If available, include the DOI or URL.
