What is the Community-Based Public Health (CBPH) Caucus?

The Community-Based Public Health Caucus was formed in 2000 by community and academic partners across the United States to promote the practice and understanding of community-based public health (CBPH) in research, teaching, and practice. We are a Caucus of the American Public Health Association (APHA). The Caucus develops focused sessions at the annual APHA meeting which highlight community-based participatory research and practice from across the United States and around the world. We also continue to explore ways of supporting community researchers and youth researchers, share opportunities and information through our Newsletter, host the National Community-Based Organization Network (NCBON), and create spaces where community-based researchers and practitioners can exchange ideas and collaborate.

How are my Membership fees used?

Membership fees are used, along with individual donations and grant funding, to support activities such as the CBPH Caucus Breakfast at the annual APHA meeting, the running of the Caucus, and scholarships for community members and youth to attend the annual APHA meeting.

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How can I become a CBPH Caucus Member?

Anyone (whether or not they are a member of the American Public Health Association (APHA)) can become an official Member of the CBPH Caucus! Membership is established through the payment of an annual membership fee.

• Adult Membership (25+ years of age): \$50.00

• Youth Membership (<25 years of age): \$25.00

Regardless of when Membership dues are received, the CBPHC Membership Year runs from the day after the APHA conference through the next year's APHA conference. Your Membership for the current year begins once your dues are received, and the next year's dues are due before the day after the APHA conference. Note: If you become a Member during the APHA conference, your dues will go towards the upcoming Membership year.
