Preamble

The parties agree to conclude this Partnership Agreement for the development of a sustainable framework for collaboration between the university and the economic and social environment in order to establish the conditions under which they will collaborate to promote mutual interests, as follows:

Art.1 Association Agreement

By signing this Partnership Agreement, the parties express their openness to designing and implementing joint actions that will address:

- **students;**
- **professors;**
- **faculty graduates**, members from the alumni community (where applicable);
- **representatives** of the partner organisation.

Art.2 Object of the Agreement

The object of this partnership is the collaboration between the two partners in the following actions:

- Establishing a permanent dialogue between the company and the university;
- Preparing students for a better insertion on the labor market by facilitating access to internships and internships, as well as informing them about the partner's job offers;
- Establishing the operational framework that allows students of the Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science within the West University of Timișoara to carry out internships / internships at the partner's location or online;
- Identifying ways of cooperation in order to develop scientific research and technology transfer;
- Organizing in partnership programs for university students in order to inform, educate and support the professional training process (*trainings, workshops, seminars, elaboration of case studies, etc.*);
- Organizing, with logistical support of UVT, events at the initiative of the partner or university, such as: round tables on various topics of interest, annual presentations of the company to be attended by students, conferences, debates, etc.
- Support offered to strengthen the alumni community by participating in events, popularizing the alumni platform, identifying new alumni members, etc.

Article 3 Principles of good practice of the Partnership Agreement

The Parties should consult regularly and keep each other informed of all aspects of the progress of projects. All partners must implement activities in compliance with the highest professional and ethical standards.

Article 4 Duration of the agreement

The duration of the agreement shall be(1 year/ 2 years/...)... starting with the date of signing this document, with the possibility of its extension by addendum signed by both parties.

Art. 5 Obligations of partners

Obligations of the UVT partner, represented by the Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science

- To ensure and respect the visual identity of the partner;
- To inform by specific means about cooperation with (name of partner)..... (brochures presenting specializations, periodic newsletter, etc.);
- To inform students and (name of partner)..... partner with the topics for internships, in accordance with the internship curriculum specific to the specialization.
- Promote joint events organized together with (name of partner)..... on official promotion channels (institution's website, Facebook page, etc.);
- To provide, within the limits of available spaces, the logistics necessary for organizing various events organized in partnership.

Obligations of the (name of partner)..... partner:

- To collaborate and support the development of joint activities by providing expertise and resources for the activities in which he/she is involved (practising experts, practice tutors, guest speakers, mentors, etc.);
- To analyze the possibility of supporting students' activity in carrying out scientific/discipline projects through designated specialists, together with academic staff;
- To transmit information that is of interest to the target group (students, teachers, UVT employees) to be disseminated on UVT promotion channels;
- To ensure adequate logistics for the collaboration (where applicable).

Art. 6 Liability of the parties

Each Party shall be responsible for the proper performance of its obligations under this Agreement.

The parties are individually liable for the observance of copyright and related rights in carrying out the subject matter of this Agreement.

Art. 7 Confidentiality

The Parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of the information received and agree to prevent any unauthorized use or disclosure of such information. The Parties agree to use confidential information only for the purpose of fulfilling their obligations under this Partnership Agreement.

Art. 8 Processing of personal data

The Parties undertake to process personal data obtained by virtue of the execution of this Agreement in compliance with the principles laid down in data protection legislation (principle of legality, fairness, transparency, accuracy, responsibility, purpose limitation and storage). Each of the Parties undertakes to implement reasonable physical, technical and administrative security measures so as to prevent incidents such as loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration or destruction of personal data. In the event of a data processing incident, each Party must notify the other within 24 hours.

Article 9 Final provisions

1. This Agreement has the character of a framework document and covers all activity to achieve the agreed common objectives. In order to carry out other actions derived from the framework objectives, the Parties shall conclude addenda to the present in which they shall establish concrete responsibilities.
