List of possible reasons to oppose the data center:

1. Insufficient road configuration and conditions
2. Economic impacts to schools and other government services due to tax abatements
3. Impacts to storm water drainage (flooding)
4. Impacts to the stream/ditch corridors on the property
5. Noise impacts to nearby properties
6. Lighting impacts to nearby properties

7. Impacts to the power grid
8. Impacts to the aquifer and water service to nearby properties
9. Proposed building heights much in excess of zoning requirements
10. Environmental impacts to wooded areas of the property
11. Massive water and power use
12. Hazardous materials to be stored on the property (diesel fuel for generators)
