



GUIDELINE FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

1. Title

- a. The title should be clear, concise, and informative, with a maximum of 20 words.
- b. It must be centered, bolded, and written in Title Case.

2. Authors and Affiliations

- a. Author names should be written as *First name (italic)* followed by *Surname (regular)*, with superscript numbers indicating affiliations.
- b. Affiliations must include Department, Faculty, Institution, City, Province/State, and Country.
- c. The corresponding author should be marked with an asterisk (*) and include an email address.

3. Abstract

- a. Abstracts must be written in clear, grammatically correct English
- b. Font: Times New Roman, size 10, with single line spacing, and justified alignment.
- c. The abstract body must be written as a single paragraph
- d. The maximum word count for the abstract is 200 words
- e. The abstract should contain: background, aim/purpose, method, result, and conclusion.
- f. Do not include figures, tables, or citations.
- g. Provide 4 to 6 keywords, separated by commas
- h. Abstract should be uploaded in word document (.doc/ .docx)
