What We Did During Week Twenty-nine

We had another great week! On the first day back we talked about why we come to school/the purpose of school. We also discussed, modeled, and practiced expectations. Once we felt like we were comfortable, we moved on to learning more about community. The students learned more about what makes their family community unique. They shared their family community with others in the classroom by participating in a mix & mingle activity.

After finishing our learning about family community, we switched gears to talk about the classroom community. To start this learning, we looked at an example of a classroom map that was drawn by an elementary school student. The students observed and discussed the different elements they saw on the map, then were tasked to create their own version of our classroom map in the PBL workbooks.

In Math, students started a new Number Corner Calendar! They will be observing and determining how many lines of symmetry each shape has on the daily markers. We are also working on both addition and subtraction story problems that involve both single and double digit equations using penguins!

On Friday, we met as a grade to share Appreciations. It is always so nice when we are all together to share thoughts and ideas!

Home learning (DOT binders) were not sent out on Friday! There are two math sheets to complete, as well as one set of questions for literacy.
