NRHA Pattern 5



Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1.Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.

2.Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.

3. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.

4.Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

5.Beginning on the left lead, run a large fast circle to the left, change leads at the center of the arena, run large fast circle to the right, and change leads at the center of the arena, (Figure 8)

6.Continue around previous circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.

7.Continue around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.

8.Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet(six meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions

1. **Cowgirl** (Arnold) – AQHA Red roan mare. Light contact. Keep inside leg off when loping (she will change leads if applied). Has a spur stop. No spur
2. **Gabby** (Arnold) - Chestnut QH mare. Light rein contact. Support with hand and use leg to collect. Division Appropriate Spurs
3. **Freddie** (Arnold) – AQHA Bay gelding. Light rein contact. Great walk trot horse. Has a spur stop. Division appropriate spurs.
4. **Sissy** (Arnold) - Bay QH mare. Light rein contact. Support with hand and use leg to collect. Set up for right lead. Hand to rail and push hip in. Division Appropriate Spurs.
5. **Kruzer** (Arnold) - Big QH gelding. Has a bouncy trot. Ride 2 handed. Division Appropriate Spurs.
6. **Dennis** (Bates) – Reiner/ranch rider. Lots of leg. Set up for right lead. Keep forward in his turns. Flying lead change. Crop option. Division appropriate spurs.
7. **Pete** (Bates) – Keep slow. Keep forward in his turns. 2 hand option. Division appropriate spurs.
8. **Blue** (Bates) – Bay all around gelding. Great pattern horse. Has a lead change. Keep soft contact. Ride from leg to hands. Division appropriate spurs.
9. **Earl** (Buckeye Riders) – Sorrel gelding. Ride leg to hand. If he is pulling on hand, use legs to soften face (don't just pull harder). Anticipates roll backs to the left. Ask to stop (use hand but not too heavy in initial back up). 2 hand option. Ball spur only.
10. **Hollywood** (Buckeye Riders) – Ride with soft/smooth hand with light contact. Legs and hands to steady through maneuvers. Steady in the ground, release leg and say WHOA. Can get excited or tight. 2 hand option. Ball spur only.
11. **Homer** (Buckeye Riders) -Set up and maintain left lead. Can get anxious in the middle when preparing to spin. Can get quick in rollbacks, finish your stops before allowing him to rollback. 2 hand option. Division appropriate spurs.
12. **King** (Buckeye Riders) – Good draw. Soft/smooth hand and legs, keep engaged in circles to prevent swapping leads. Division appropriate spurs.
13. **Gigi** (Concord) –Bay mare. Very straight forward and EASY to ride. Pull and release to keep her slow., use your legs as well. No spurs or crop.
14. **Cowboy** (Concord) – Paint chestnut gelding. Takes a lot of leg to hand to keep rounded up. Can go slow if you keep him round. Flying lead change. Don't trap him up in his turn around otherwise he will back up. **Rowel spurs.**
15. **Hannah** (Concord) – Buckskin mare. Set up for right lead. Easy and straightforward. Crop option. Ball spurs or no spurs.
16. **Jerry** (Concord) – Bay gelding. Very quiet and likes to be lazy. More leg than hand; likes a looser rein. Ball spurs only.
17. **JR** (Concord) – Sorrel gelding. Lazy! Takes leg and riding to keep him going forward. Flying lead change, great turn arounds. Don't overuse your spurs or he will kick out. **Rowel spurs.**
18. **Mercedes** (Concord) – Bay mare. Does not bridle up. Set up for left lead. Lazy. Crop option. Division appropriate spurs.
19. **Reggie** (Concord) – Bay gelding. Very kind, gets excited but very good at all maneuvers. Not a big stopper so do not run hard to the stops. Ball spurs only.
20. **Wesley** (Concord) – Bay roan gelding. Soft hand and cues. Will suck back in turn arounds so keep hand forward. Green riding one handed so can be ridden one or to handed. No spurs.
21. **Whiz** (Concord) – Chestnut gelding. Fun horse to ride! Circling machine, will suck back in turn arounds so do not pull back to start turns. Pull lightly into stops. Division appropriate spurs.
22. **Klu** (DMB) – Easy to move forward into gates, loves a quiet voice cue, soft legs and rein contact.
23. **Prada** (DMB) – Straight forward draw, soft rein contact. Keep encouraging forward through all gates, rides like a ranch horse. 2 hand option. Ball spur option.

24. **Wyatt** (DMB) – Soft loose rein contact. Wyatt has a toppling and is very easy going. 2 hand option. Ball spur option.
25. **Chex** (EQD) - QH Gelding. Two handed for ranch classes. 2 hand option for everything else. Reining trained. Has a more forward way of going but will slow down if you press your seat down and feet into stirrups. Quiet moving on the rail. Can have a big lead change. Leg release stop and sit down. Stops a little stiff and hard. Spins great
26. **Riley** (EQD) – Sorrel QH Gelding. Light rein contact. Soft legs. If he wants to go slow, let him. Don't be pushy. - Soft cues for leads and pattern work. Soft legs for jog transition, soft consistent push for lope. Division appropriate spurs, but don't overuse them.
27. **Rose** (EQD) – Bay QH mare. Is super sensitive to all hand/leg/voice cues. Maintain rein contact and adjust as needed. Is spur broke and will stop in gaits if over touched with hand and too much leg is used. Soft legs for jog transition, soft consistent push for lope Has a spur stop, but NO spurs or crop..
28. **Tequila** (EQD) - QH mare. She can go 1 or 2 handed, is a little lazy but has very sensitive skin (ball spurs would be fine). She keeps her head long and low so they have to reach forward to steer pretty if they ride one handed. She's best if you go easy on the accelerator to build speed or else she will do cranky mare face. Easy turn, change and rollback. Just don't rush her and breath between maneuvers. Just come straight through the center and kiss to change.
29. **Duke** (Hancock) – Good draw. Light to medium contact – Do Not Trap. Set up for right lead. Ball spur only.
30. **Jake** (Hancock) – Great draw. Easy to ride. Ball spur only.
31. **Macey** (Hancock) – Nice draw. Light to medium contact. She will go slow if you hold her – Do not trap her. Smooth to ride. No spurs.
32. **Playboy** (Hancock) – Great draw. Easy to ride. Hold him in run downs he will get strong. Ball spur only.
33. **Slick** (Hancock) -Great draw. Lazy, set up for right lead. Crop option for walk trot. Ball spur only.
34. **Zeek** (Indiana Elite) – AQHA Retired show horse, all around. Spur trained. Bridles down well, use your legs.
35. **Hank** (Indiana Elite) - AQHA show horse. Spur trained, very dull sited. To collect close legs, support with hands and hum. Two hand option, division appropriate spurs.
36. **Bonnie** (Riding on Faith) – Ride with leg, seat and hands. Rides better with head level or becomes bouncy. Use outside rein on circles and spins. Spur stop, must close leg before spur. Simple and flying lead change. Squeeze to back. Two hands. Ball spurs only.
37. **Scout** (Riding on Faith) – Squeeze before you cluck to trot and back. Medium contact on face, light contact with legs or he will speed up.
38. **Tuffy** (Riding on Faith) – Soft contact on face. Use seat to slow. Set up for leads. Has a slow jog but will start quick if asked too fast.
39. **Eric** (SL Equestrian) - Reiner/ranch rider. Quiet hands and legs. 2 hand option. Division appropriate spurs.
40. **Izzy** (SL Equestrian) – Very ranchy, can do reining. Has slow turnaround. Ask don't tell right away. Can be a very good draw. Division appropriate spurs.
41. **Riot** (SL Equestrian) –Reiner. 2 hand option. Division appropriate spurs.
42. **Arie** (SL Equestrian) – Great draw. Very ranchy. Can be lazy. Division appropriate spurs.
43. **Diva** (Southern Ohio) - Super slow, cluck for the jog. Voice commands “whoa” and “easy”. Sit deep in the saddle. Keep hands low and quiet. Squeeze and say “back” to back. Can lift up a bit to back and/or stop (along with voice command),, but don't need to pull back. As little bit/face contact as possible.

44. **Coco** (Southern Ohio) - Bay QH Gelding. Use quiet hands & consistent, but light contact. He will pull against the bit if reins are too short or if you pull on his face. Responds to voice commands. Cluck & wave legs for jog. If you cue to aggressively or kick for jog, you will get a long trot. Kiss and outside leg pressure for lope. Responds best to easy/light legs/cues. Will respond to spur stop or neck rein. Spurs can be used to slow, collect, or set head, and can be used according to division. However, spurs not recommended for riders not familiar with spur-trained horses, as you will not need spurs for forward motion and if they are used in that way, you will not get your best ride. He has very slow jog and lope with correct use of spurs or no spurs, but will move out with a (very safe, but faster) hunt seat stride with overuse of spurs or more aggressive cues.
45. **Boone** (Southern Ohio) – Can have more rein contact in divisions with no spurs; check back and release for slower jog; use voice commands along with cluck for jog, kiss for lope; maintain forward motion for flying lead change; lift reins, slight pull and squeeze for back, but release contact with verbal whoa to stop, or he will continue backing. Lift reins; use body and outside leg for turns and spins (use leg just before moving hand(s) left or right). Neck reins well, but two-hand (option) may be preferred for more difficult patterns and/or Ranch Riding.
46. **Jet** (Southern Ohio) - Black QH gelding. Light rein contact and LOTS of leg/spur. If contact is too tight, he won't move forward. Use spurs according to division and if none are allowed, a crop is permitted. Cluck & kick for jog; Kiss & cue for lope. Increase forward motion for flying lead change. Can be very lazy but does very well with a confident rider not afraid to use legs or spurs. Continue kissing and consistent leg contact through lope if he gets too slow/uncollected. Use inside leg and body position to keep him from cutting corners in rail work.
47. **Lexi** (Southern Ohio) – Bay QH/Paint mare. Cluck to jog, kiss to lope. Support with leg/calf pressure, particularly at the lope. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
48. **Ruby** (Southern Ohio) - Appaloosa Mare (red roan look). Use consistent, but light contact. She will get cranky if reins are too short or if you pull on her face. Responds to voice commands. Cluck & kick lightly for jog and kiss/cue for lope. Whoa/Walk. Will respond to spur stop or neck rein. Spurs allowed according to division. Two-hand option for lower divisions or those not able or accustomed to using leg/spur and body position for turns.
49. **T** (Southern Ohio) - Palomino QH Gelding. Ranch type. Responds best to voice commands. Hum and sit deep and release legs to slow a Lots of leg pressure to speed up (can be lazy). Cluck and kick for jog/trot. Kiss and cue for lope. Say Whoa, sit deep and release legs to stop. Less likely to break in extended trot if you post vs stand. Prefers a looser rein, but can be taken in for horsemanship patterns. Spurs according to division.
50. **Chisum** (Need a Hand) – Great draw. Ranch pony. When guiding in patterns ask with leg first and then help with hand or he will get counter bent. Hum to slow, does better with posting the extended trot or he may lope. Division appropriate spurs.
51. **Diamond** (Need a Hand) – Finished reiner. Can be lazy, ride her forward every stride in the circle, spins cluck and kick. Not a very fast spinner. For stop, sit and say whoa. Division appropriate spurs.
52. **Gunador** (Need a Hand) – Ride leg to hand in horsemanship. Reining start spins with hand, cluck and add leg to speed up. If you rush him he will hop. Likes to drop right shoulder in circles. Keep straight in middle in changes. Keep organized and slow for rundowns or he will go really fast. Division appropriate spurs.
53. **Dell** (TMC) – Ride leg to hand. Nice easy jog. 2 hand option. Spur option??
