

Cheat sheet: Twine

Moving between pages:

1. `[[next page]]`
2. `[[name -> nextpage]]` (shows name, but when clicked will go to nextpage)
3. `[name <- nextpage]]` (shows nextpage, but when clicked goes to name)

Types of variable:

1. \$variable
 - a. Global variable, which means it can be used throughout your story.
 - b. You must have the dollar sign before the variable name.
 - c. The name of your variable cannot begin with a number.
2. _variable
 - a. Local variable, only used in that specific passage.

Defining Variables:

1. (set: \$variable **to** value)
2. (put: value **into** \$variable)

* Both of these functions or macros will create, define, and change the value of a variable

Conditional statements:

- (if: \$variable **is** value) [this is the text that will show]
- (else:)[this text will show]
- (elseif: \$variable **is** value) [this text will show]

*for else and elseif functions or macros you must have an if statement before it.

*if you are still confused about conditional statements watch [this video](#) .

Adding images:

1.
 - a. Add this in the passage wherever you want the image to be, so if you add it at the bottom, the image will be at the bottom. If you add it in the middle the image will be in the middle.

Stylesheet:

- This changes the look of all of you passages.
- You MUST put all code in the parenthesis with tw-story → **tw-story{ }**

- Example:

```
tw-story{ background: cyan; color: navy; font-size: 50; }
```

- For links all code must go inside **tw-link{ ... }**

- Tw-link{

Color: red; } - For when your mouse hovers over the link the code goes inside

tw-link:hover{ ... } - CSS cheatsheet

- Background color -> background: (*name of a color*);
- Text color -> color: (*name of a color*);
- Font size - font-size: (*number*)
- Font

-> font-family: (*three different fonts separated by commas*); - For more things you can change and a list of color [click here](#)

- The syntax for what is outside the parentheses is different than what is on the website.

Text changers:

Bold 'text'

*for this to work you must use 2 single quotations

Superscript text² text²

Strikethrough text ~~text~~ text

Adding Sound:

- Search for a sound on [freesound](#)
 - Right-click on page and select View Page Source
 - Search for .mp3
 - Highlight & copy the URL it found
- Or you can use [Earsketch](#)
- Record a sound or script. You'll need to share it on the web somewhere. You may be able to upload to a padlet.

THEN

- Add following code to the page you want sound on and replace with sound URL

you just copied

- `<audio src="the URL of your sound effect" autoplay>`

Submitting your project

- Select triangle next to your story name (near bottom left corner) and then Publish to File. Upload this file as your submission to the challenge.
