6. DISCUSSION: Equity in identification practices (what are the best methods)

- a. Council has discussed portfolio means of identification combined with universal screening using local norms, cultural norms, and socio-economic norms for under-represented populations to gain a more comprehensive population of gifted learners.
- b. Talent development and evaluation process combined with program offerings in order to provide identification.
- c. Council compared identification means through the different universal screening tests offered. CogAT offers a Composite score encompassing verbal, quantitative, and nonverbal abilities along with a variety of norm reports to choose from based on population/representation.
- d. Some districts consider teacher recommendations and gifted characteristics, combined with under-represented populations and socioeconomic factors when determining GATE eligibility.
- e. Districts are differentiating their qualifying thresholds based on EL proficiencies.
- f. Discussed the opportunity to translate the provided universal screening assessment for students to be evaluated in their native language. CogAT and OLSAT do not have questions in Spanish.
- g. Districts discussing balance and equity priorities and requirements in identification.
