

OSU!comp – Weekly Skill-Bracket Tournaments

Overview:

OSU!comp is a recurring weekly tournament series designed to cater to different skill brackets on a rotating basis. Each week focuses on a specific rank range, ensuring fair competition and varied playstyles. The format changes depending on the bracket to keep things engaging and competitive.

Weekly Rotation:

- **Week 1 – 6-Digit and Lower Players**
Format: Battle Royale elimination. After each round, the lowest-scoring player is eliminated until a final winner remains.
- **Week 2 – 5-Digit and Lower Players**
Format: Identical to the 6-digit bracket – a Battle Royale elimination system.
- **Week (3 - 4) – 4-Digit and Lower Players**
Format: Traditional tournament structure with (qualifiers), Round of 32, and subsequent knockout stages.
- **Week (5 - 6) – open rank**
Format: Same as the 4-digit bracket – (qualifiers) followed by a standard elimination tournament.

Special Qualification:

Winners of the 4-digit and open rank tournaments earn a spot in the **Annual New Year Championship**, held each January. This exclusive event will bring together the best of the best from the previous year's high-tier competitions.
