

## Call for Submissions:

Europa Sun is an independent publication operating on a low-budget. Our pages are filled by volunteer contributors who are passionate about celebrating and promoting a positive view of European cultural heritage.

Content: We are seeking articles on ethnic-European history and culture. This magazine is open to almost any topic pertaining to European heritage from history, to literature, art, philosophy, and so forth. We seek to represent our culture accurately but positively.

Articles are not required to be political in nature. But, we do veer toward a nationalist perspective (that is, we respect the cultures from which we descend).

## Format:

- Personal essays should be between 700-1250 words.
- Researched historical articles should aim for no more 2,500 3,500 words. Articles over the word limit may be trimmed, with some exceptions. Do not use foot notes. MLA style in-text citations are preferred at the author's discretion.
- But do include a short bibliography for researched articles.
- Please send submissions as **a doc file** (or Google Docs).

- Do NOT place any images in the body of the text. We cannot use copyrighted images. It is not necessary for an author to illustrate their article, but if you choose to send images, we can only use public domain, free to use (creative commons license), the author's own art/photos, or with permission of the artist. If you choose to include images, please send them as attachments within the email and include caption information.
- If you use a pen name, please put a note at the top of the document with your real name and the name you want the piece attributed to.
- Include a short byline at the end of your article, just a few sentences about the author, including any mentions of your own website, any projects you would like to promote, etc.
