

Amendment Conflict Tie Amendment

A necessary and legal way to solve conflicting amendment votes.
Solving votes and constitutional crises where 2 amendments at the same time change the same things.

Section 6: Amendment/Constitution Contradictions

- A. If an amendment contradicts the constitution in any way, the amendment will overrule the constitution.
- B. If there are two or more amendments which tries to change the same section of the constitution or otherwise conflict, only one may be passed.
 - a. The Moderation with a 2/4 vote will decide which amendments are guilty of this. This decision can be revoked by the Supreme Court with a 50%-vote.
 - b. Which one passes will be decided using the following procedure: At the same time, as all of the conflicting amendments go through a standard approval vote (66% required). If more than one of the amendments are approved, the one with higher approval percentage pass.
 - i. There shall also be a FPTP vote among them, where in case of the highest approved amendments have tied approval percentages, the one with the highest amount of FPTP votes of the tied and approved amendments will pass.
 - c. An amendment rejected by the public, may be be put to a new vote through a petition at a later date. It should be readapted to the new constitutional changes though.
