

ACT Preparation Information

All juniors have to take the ACT plus science and essay at MCHS in the Spring for **NO** charge as part of the State testing. Students will register for this test during the school day in a group setting. Students are able to select four colleges to have their scores sent. (We will not be sending test scores with student transcripts when they apply to colleges next year.) Students will be able to access their scores in late May. Please note, MCHS will not send test scores with a student's transcript unless written permission by a parent/guardian is received.

Students are encouraged to participate in ACT preparation seminars/workshops.
