Timeline of Milestones for LA Animal Services Budget

At any of these dates (or in between) there could be cuts made to the Animal Services Budget. We cannot afford to lose one dollar because even with the \$5 million put back into the budget, the cost of supplies have all gone up. Medicine, food, and cleaning supplies cost more than last year. So \$10,000 or \$20,000 (or more) removed from the Animal Service budget between May 1 - May 30 could be the difference of another carton of medicine purchased or not purchased each month.

Monday 5/5, 9:00am

Animal Services has their budget hearing with the City Council. Their update should provide more clarity to what operations will look like with the \$5 million put back into the budget. .

Thursday, 5/8 9:00am

The Budget committee will vote on all proposed changes to the Mayor's budget (including adding the \$5 million back in to Animal Services)

Friday, 5/16 1:00pm

Committee will review all their proposed changes and finalize their version of the budget.

Wed. 5/21 10:00am

All 15 city council members will consider the committee's budget and public comment.

Thurs, 5/22 9:00am

Full council will vote on the final budget.

Then the Council's budget goes to the Mayor to either be signed or vetoed.

Here's the \$5 million dollar question

“What's my City Council District?” “Who is my Councilmember?”

This is the most important act and why we need a tool kit. Most people do not know there are 15 council districts in LA and they probably have no idea the name of their councilmember.

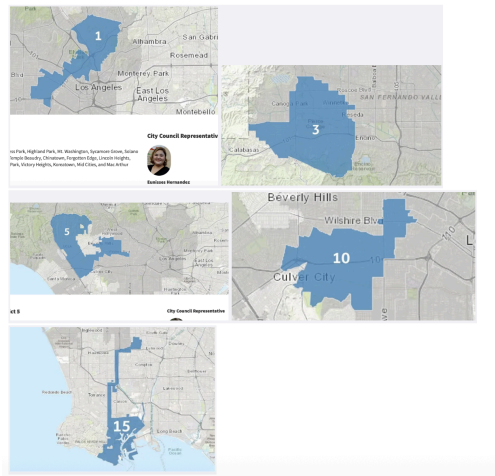

Script to talk to people - Super Easy

Your easy discussion with friends, family, people at dog parks, pet stores, adoption fairs, vet's offices, etc.

“Hi.... Are you up to speed on the potential budget cuts at LA city shelters?”

Unlike other departments in the city, Animal Services has sustained regular cuts over the last decade and is already working at a bare bone budget. It can not sustain any more cuts.

The city council is going through the budget during the month of May. On the last day of April they moved money into the budget for Animal Shelters but there is no guarantee that they will let it remain whole. They could chip away at the funding during the process (May 1-30) and animal shelters will end up with less when it is approved. We are asking people to email and/or call their city council members and tell them NO cuts to animal services and keep the budget as it was last year.

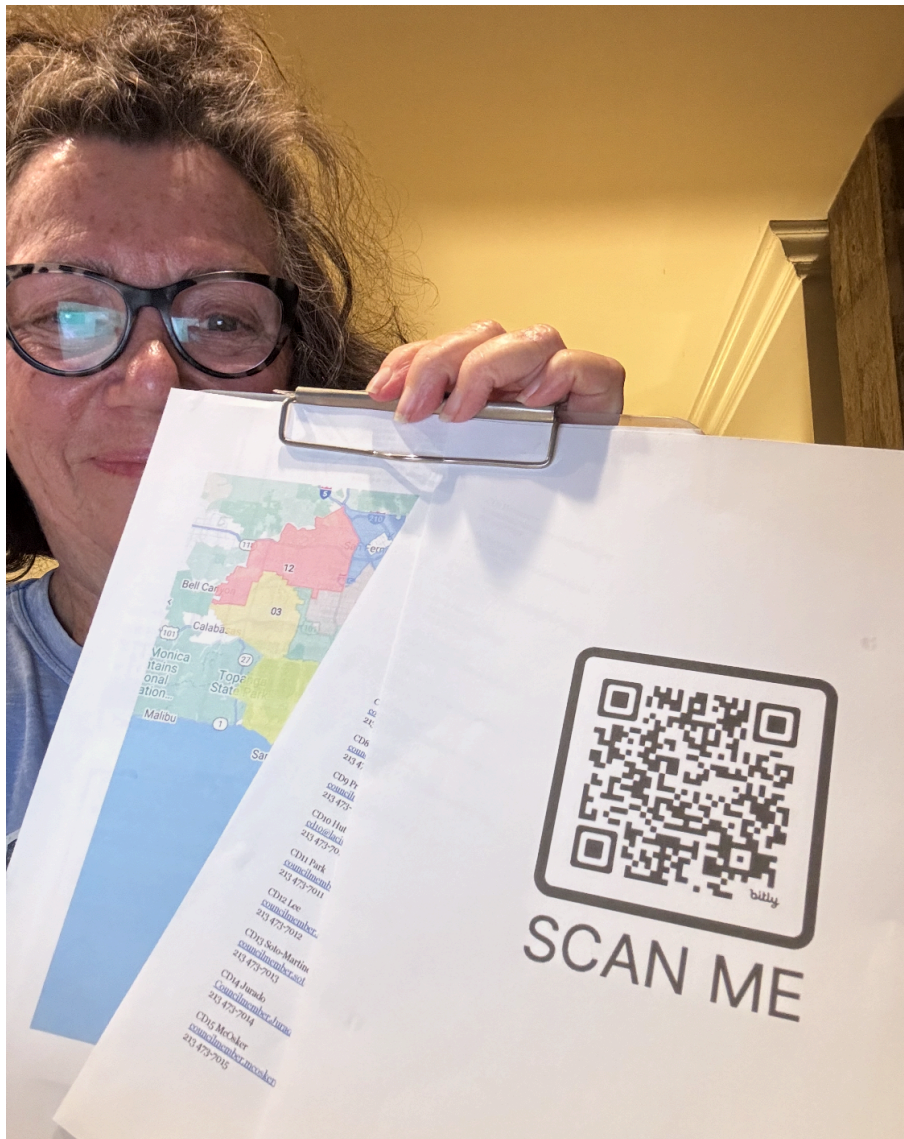
