

QUESTION	ANSWER
When will online learning end?	Teachers will not send any new work home after Friday, 5/15. Students may continue to turn in work and complete assignments until Thursday, 5/21.

Do I still have to do school work, even if I am satisfied with my grade?	Our expectation is that students maintain a normal schedule and structure each day regardless of your current grade. We recommend 2-3, 30-minute distraction-free time blocks to get work done. Engagement in school is both good for you both academically and for your mental health. The work you complete will help prepare you for the next grade level.
Who do I contact with questions about assignments?	If you have questions about specific assignments, please contact the teacher who assigned it through email.
What if I don't know my teacher's email address?	A district staff directory can be found <a href="#">here</a> .
Is summer school still being held?	No, not for 6th or 7th grade TMS students. Upcoming 9th graders may take summer school for advancement. The summer school informational flyer can be found <a href="#">here</a> . Summer school registration can be done <a href="#">here</a> .
When can I pick up my refunds from field trips or my cookie dough?	On Monday, 5/4 we will host a pick up. An adult may come to a table outside to collect refunds for field trips. Cookie dough will be distributed to cars. No one may enter the building at this time. We will schedule times in later May for students who need to get things inside the building.
When can I pick up spring photos, yearbooks, my student's locker contents, etc?	We are planning a date for pick-up during the final week of school (week of 5/18). At this time we are still making plans for how this will work and will make a general announcement the week before.
Will I need to bring my chromebook, library book, or school materials to be turned in this May?	No. At this time we plan to collect materials in August. Please contact the school administration if you are moving and will not be present in August.

What are the eligibility requirements for upcoming fall sports? Have they changed?	Eligibility is still the same at this time. During your last quarter you must have passed (5) classes to be eligible for the fall sports season. You must also have at least a 2.0 GPA.
Where can I find the information on food distribution?	The sites and times are listed on the District <a href="#">website</a> . All students are welcome to participate!
If I haven't gotten food from the food distribution, but need to now, what do I do?	You can receive food at any distribution point on any Monday and Friday. One meal kit per child will be provided. There is no sign up required, just arrive at any of the distribution sites!
How will 3rd Trimester grades be averaged?	Since we will not return to TMS in a traditional sense, we will be freezing student grades as of 3/12/2020. All online learning opportunities will only increase a student's grade. Teachers will be giving additional credit for online work weekly. For example, a student who had a 70% on 3/12/20 can only improve that score for a final 3rd trimester grade.
