Programme card: On joining, you will be given a card listing club events and green fees at each course, and contact details. Once it has been made, you will get a membership badge.

Pre-registration: You will get an email a week or two before each event asking if you would like to play. Reply promptly as numbers are usually limited to 120 players. Cards are pre-printed for collection on arrival. You can still turn up without pre-registering, but occasionally there may not be any spaces.

Cart hire: If you wish to hire a cart, you will need to book this yourself by contacting the venue directly. Anyone is welcome to use a cart.

Arrival time: Arrive at least 60 mins prior to gunshot start at the starter's office or pro shop to pay your green fee (and cart hire, if applicable), and collect your pre-printed card. Then proceed to the club lounge for tee allocation. If playing at your home club, pay \$5 to our Secretary in the lounge.

Tee allocation: Take your card to the club lounge immediately after printing to get a tee allocated. The "early birds" get the best tees! Please say if you are using a cart as these players can start further from the clubhouse. You can put in up to 4 cards together if you have a group you wish to play with.

Raffle tickets: Raffle tickets (\$5 for 3 tickets) are available in the lounge. Members are encouraged to support the raffle, our main source of income for prizes.

Meeting 30 min prior to shotgun start: We have a brief meeting in the lounge to make announcements about the day's competition, local course rules and conditions, and to introduce any new members. After this, we go straight out to the course to our allocated tees.

Shotgun start: Programme indicates start time.

Play: 15cm clean and place in the general area at all courses. You must putt out - NO "gimmies". Pick up if you cannot score a stableford point. Keep up with the group in front.

Prize-giving & Social time: Held in the clubhouse immediately after the round. The top players are awarded cash prizes, and others who played well or got 2s are given new balls. Winners of ball prizes must be present to receive their ball - if not, the ball will be given to the next best player. We encourage all players to support the venue by buying drinks and food since clubs give us a good discount on the green fees.
