

<b>Club Displays:</b>	Clubs should bring scrapbooks, posters of club activities, German related projects, etc to give new German Clubs an opportunity to see what is going on around the state.
<b>Poster - Staatskongress Theme:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Must be normal poster board (22" x 28")</li> <li>· Can be in color or black and white</li> <li>· Must be original, with no copyrighted figures</li> <li>· All words must be in <b>German</b>. Grammar and Correctness is taken into account.</li> <li>· The poster must relate to the theme of this year's Staatskongress.</li> </ul>
<b>Poster - Charts or Maps:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Charts and maps may vary in size and media.</li> <li>· Charts or maps teach or clarify.</li> <li>· Cite the sources of the chart or map.</li> </ul> <p>Charts and Maps must be in <b>German</b>, if language is used. Grammar and Correctness is taken into account</p>
<b>Photo Essay:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· This may be an individual or group project.</li> <li>· Photos may either be in black and white, color, or a combination of both.</li> <li>· Any size photo is acceptable.</li> <li>· The minimum number of photos is 10, and the maximum is 20.</li> <li>· Photos may be mounted on only one sheet of poster board (22" x 28") OR in a multi-page binder/folder with clear protective plastic sleeves to preserve the display.</li> <li>· Photos may concern any subject, but they must be accompanied by a narrative story in <b>German</b>. Grammar and Correctness is taken into account.</li> <li>· The story must be written on or attached to the poster board/Binder next to or under the pictures.</li> </ul>

<p><b>Shirt Design*:</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· No German Club T-shirts.</li> <li>· Must be German related, with all words in German.</li> <li>· No store bought decals.</li> <li>· The design may be silk-screened, painted or stitched on a T-shirt or sweatshirt.</li> </ul> <p>The judging criteria are as follows:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Design and Words: 40%                      Difficulty: 20%</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Originality and Creativity: 40%</p>								
<p><b>Art*:</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Artwork must have a recognizable German theme.</li> <li>· Media considered in this competition are as follows:</li> </ul> <table border="1" data-bbox="483 804 1419 926" style="width: 100%; text-align: center;"> <tr> <td>Watercolor</td> <td>Oil or Acrylic</td> <td>Ink</td> <td>Mixed</td> </tr> <tr> <td>Pastel</td> <td>Pencil</td> <td>Charcoal</td> <td>Media</td> </tr> </table> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· All entries must be a single picture and be backed with a stiff mat board.</li> <li>· Entries must be matted, but wood or metal frames will not be allowed.</li> <li>· Pictures have a minimum size requirement of 8" x 10".</li> <li>· The source of the picture, or whether it is original work of the student, should also be indicated.</li> <li>· The judging criteria are the same as for Shirt Design</li> </ul>	Watercolor	Oil or Acrylic	Ink	Mixed	Pastel	Pencil	Charcoal	Media

<p><b>Handicrafts*:</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Every article must illustrate a clearly recognizable German theme or subject.</li> <li>· The following explanations may give some direction to your projects: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· <u>Sculpture</u> - Should be handmade only, no molds, and should be a figure of some sort, either a dome, in the round, or a relief cut from a flat surface.</li> <li>· <u>Models</u> - Should fit inside a box that is no larger the 24" x 24".</li> <li>· <u>Handmade Clothing</u> - Made to fit a doll, a child, or you.</li> </ul> </li> <li>· The judging criteria are the same as for Shirt Design.</li> </ul>								
<p><b>Games:</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Board games or playing cards to be used in learning German.</li> </ul>								

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· All games must be entirely original, and all writing must be typewritten or legibly printed in ink.</li> <li>· They must include use of the German language and/or culture, and must include all instructions for playing.</li> <li>· Instructions may be in German or English.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Miscellaneous*:</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Miscellaneous culture projects are those which do not fall into any of the other categories.</li> <li>· Projects may not be entered in the miscellaneous category simply to avoid penalty for failure to comply with rules in another category.</li> <li>· Any cartoons or other characters must be original.</li> <li>· Judging criteria are the same as for Shirt Design.</li> </ul> <p>Projects entered may be subject to judge's discretion about the proper category.</p>
<p><b>Lebkuchen-hauser*:</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Use any recipe</li> <li>· All parts of the house must be edible including all reinforcement</li> <li>· Minimum length and/or width is 8 inches</li> <li>· Any animals or figures must be edible</li> <li>· The house may be placed on a board</li> <li>· All houses must be built from scratch by the student(s). No kits.</li> <li>· All displays must include a recipe</li> </ul>
<p><b>Lebkuchen-people*:</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· A decorating contest.</li> <li>· Be original.</li> <li>· Two or more gingerbread people, completely edible.</li> <li>· All displays must have the recipe included.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Cookies*:</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· A taste contest.</li> <li>· Each contestant must bring twelve cookies, prepared at home.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· The recipe must be included and come from a German speaking country.</li> <li>· NO RECIPES WITH ALCOHOL PERMITTED</li> </ul>
<b>Kuchen/ Torten*:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· A taste contest.</li> <li>· Must be baked at home</li> <li>· No refrigeration is available.</li> <li>· The recipe must be included and must come from a German speaking country.</li> <li>· Suggestions: Obstkuchen, Schwarzwaelderkirschtorte, Haselnusskuchen, Pflaumenkuchen, Zwiebelkuchen, Stollen, <b>BUT NO GERMAN CHOCOLATE CAKE.</b></li> <li>· NO RECIPES WITH ALCOHOL PERMITTED</li> </ul>
<b>Breads/ Rolls*:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· A taste contest.</li> <li>· Must be baked at home.</li> <li>· No refrigeration is available.</li> <li>· The recipe must be included and must come from a German speaking country.</li> <li>· Please bring real butter and Marmelade, Honig, or Nutella when entering an item in this category.</li> <li>· Display all items on the table together.</li> <li>· NO RECIPES WITH ALCOHOL PERMITTED</li> </ul>
<b>Schokolade*:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· A taste contest as well as a visual one (shapes, etc.).</li> <li>· Must be baked at home.</li> <li>· No refrigeration is available.</li> <li>· The recipe must be included and must come from a German speaking country.</li> <li>· NO RECIPES WITH ALCOHOL PERMITTED</li> </ul>
<b>Marzipan Figuren*:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· A taste contest as well as a visual one (shapes, etc.).</li> <li>· Must be baked at home.</li> <li>· No refrigeration is available.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· The recipe must be included and must come from a German speaking country.</li> <li>· NO RECIPES WITH ALCOHOL PERMITTED</li> </ul>
<b>Other*:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· A taste contest.</li> <li>· Must be baked at home.</li> <li>· No refrigeration available.</li> <li>· The recipe must be included and must come from a German speaking country.</li> <li>· Suggestions include: Rote Gruetze, Feuerzangenbowle, Gluehwein/Kinderpunsch, Eierlikoer (all non-alcoholic, natuerlich!)</li> </ul> <p>If utensils are needed for tasting, please provide the judges with these upon entry.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· NO RECIPES WITH ALCOHOL PERMITTED</li> </ul>
<b>Muehle*:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· A board game.</li> </ul> <p>Games must be handmade and all materials used to play must be handcrafted. .</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Contestants will be expected to know the rules. (A workshop will be conducted just prior to the competition!)</li> <li>· Schools must limit their participants to three students.</li> </ul>
