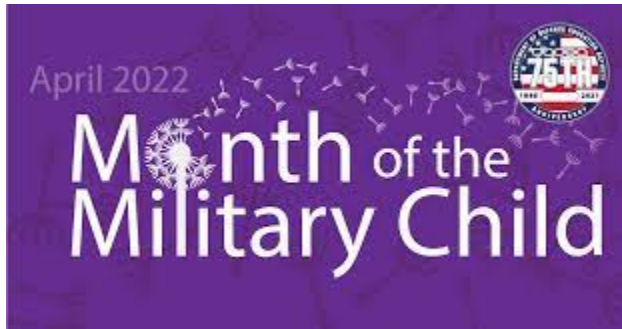
Forrestal Student Pledge

D187 Mask Mandate Update: D187 will maintain the current mask mandate until April 1. If COVID numbers regionally continue to be low, and if D187 does not see a spike in infections in schools during the five days after break, then starting April 4th masks will be optional at the high school and middle school. **Starting April 11 masks will be optional at the elementary schools.** Masks will continue to be required at Green Bay for the time being because there is currently not a vaccination option for our youngest learners.

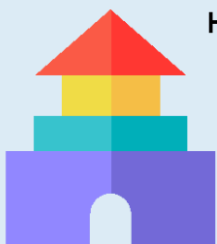
