Summary:

Today's generation is the first generation to see the impacts of the decline of our endangered species and the last that can do something about it. A flotilla of partners are working together to promote young people around the world to engage in Earth Day and support the signing of the Paris Agreement at the UN on April 22. This is a year of protecting the species action, we need to move from agreements to implementation and transition to a resilient low-carbon future.

The Facts: Declining and Endangered Species

- Land-dwelling wildlife species have declined by 40% since 1970.
- Marine animal populations have fallen by 40% overall.
- Birds populations have been reduced by about 20-25%.
- Freshwater animal populations have plummeted by 75% since 1970.

This coordinated media effort is a commitment to educating, engaging, and raising the voice of youth in support of protecting endangered species action. In order to create a powerful presence during this defining moment, we need your help! This toolkit provides you with all the information you need to engage in the #Youth4Species social media campaign, as well as equip you with a list of important youth and protecting the species education initiatives taking place this year. This document will be kept up to date by all partners involved.

Young people are one of the largest demographics in the world — approximately one billion youth roam the globe today. Protecting Endangered Species education can be a necessary foundation for young people. In order to tackle this decline of endangered species or threatened species we should teach young people to care about — land animals, sea creatures, and plants around the world which have seen their numbers severely reduced.
