How to use a Tumblr page via a theme:

Rundown: instead of <u>your-blog.tumblr.com/page-name</u>, use the page as the theme of a new side blog so that it becomes <u>your-new-blog.tumblr.com</u>. Mostly used as an alternative to <u>manually approving JavaScript usage for your account</u>.

Instructions:

- 1. Create a new side blog: https://www.tumblr.com/new/blog
- 2. For the **blog title**, give it anything you like.
- 3. When picking a **blog name**, I recommend picking a URL that reflects the purpose of the page you're about to use. So e.g. I want this side blog for displaying my about page, I could call it something like about-glen:




4. For the Privacy part, do not tick "password protect the blog".




- Complete the Captcha and Create Blog.
- 6. Once it's created, go to its settings page: https://www.tumblr.com/settings/blog/your-new-blog-name

If my blog name is about-glen, I would go to https://www.tumblr.com/settings/blog/about-glen

7. Scroll down to **Custom Theme** and turn the option on (blue):




8. Next, scroll down to **Visibility** and make sure that this option is turned off (gray):



 Now we can go to your new blog's customize page: https://www.tumblr.com/customize/your-new-blog-name

If my blog name is about-glen, I would go to https://www.tumblr.com/customize/about-glen

10. Click Edit HTML:



- 11. Clear everything in the code editor.
- 12. Paste in the code for the page you want to use. (e.g. about page, character page) I'm using a very basic one that uses JavaScript as an example: https://snips.sh/f/HePMOjqN14?r
- 13. Make your changes/customizations as you need, then **Update Preview** and **Save**.
- 14. To view your new page in action, go to: https://your-new-blog-name.tumblr.com

If my blog name is **about-glen**, I would go to https://about-glen.tumblr.com
