Elegant Borders Awash in Beauty Card Instructions

- 161593 - Elegant Borders Dies
- 159183 - Stylish Shapes Dies

Cutting Instructions

- Merry Merlot CS: 8-½" x 5-½" scored at 4-¼"; small scrap
- Basic White CS: 5-½" x 4-⅛"; 5-¼" x 4"; 2-½" x 1-¼"
- Awash in Beauty DSP: 5-¾" x 2-¼" (for flap of envelope)
- Awash in Beauty DSP with large flowers for die cutting

Assembly Instructions

1. Die cut flowers and leaves from DSP.
2. Die cut the berries from the Merry Merlot CS.
3. Use the Elegant Borders die on the long right edge of the 5-½" x 4-⅛" piece of Basic White CS and glue this piece to the front of your card leaving a ⅛" border on the left side.
4. Glue the stem with leaves to the center of the Basic White panel, then

- glue the blue flowers, then glue the Merry Merlot berries.
5. Put Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of the large flower and place it at the top of the stem.
6. Tie a bow with the gold trim. Put a rolled up glue dot behind the bow and place the bow on the stem at the base of the large flower.
7. Using the Merry Merlot ink pad Stamp "Happy Birthday" in the center of the 2-½" x 1-¼" piece of Basic White CS. Die cut it with the longest of the two short stitched labels from the Stylish Shapes Dies. I used a sponge dauber to put a bit of Merry Merlot ink around the label. Put two Stampin' Dimensionals on the back and place it so the bottom of the stems are covered.
8. Place three blue gems on the front of the card.
9. Stamp a sentiment in Merry Merlot ink on the 5-¼" x 4" piece of Basic White CS and glue it to the right inside flap of your card.
10. Glue a leaf and a couple of the small flowers that you die cut out of the DSP.
11. Glue the 5-¾" x 2-¼" piece of DSP to the flap of your envelope and trim around it.

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
