Net Impact's Mentorship Program provides students with a valuable opportunity to enhance their business acumen and foster connections within a community of like-minded individuals.

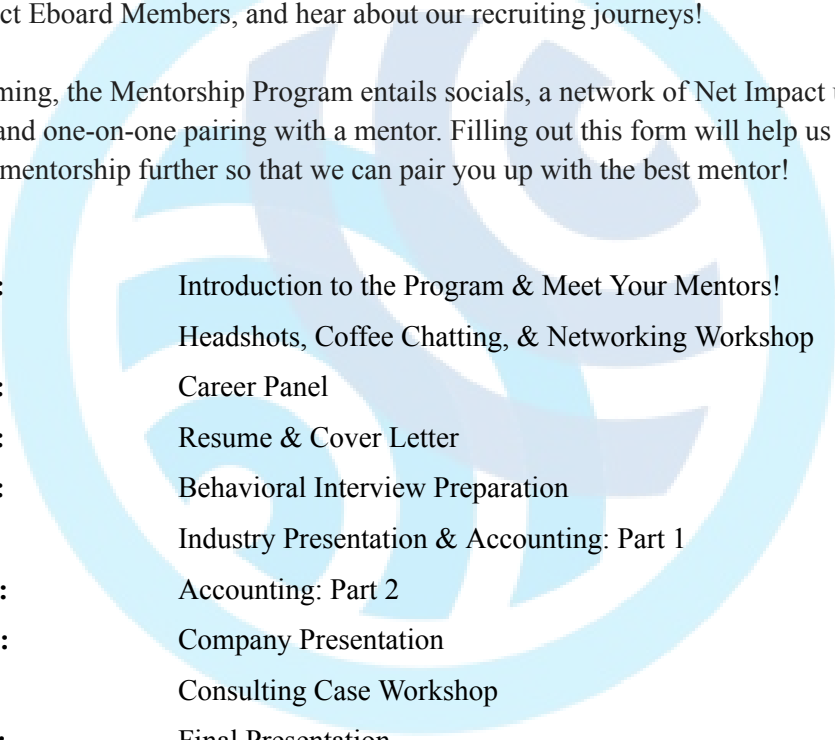
Program Details

The program meets for an hour and a half every week throughout the semester and is open to students who are starting their first year in New York (freshmen, transfers, returning FYLO students, and students who spent their first year abroad). Interested students can apply by submitting the written application when the cycle opens at the beginning of every semester.

The program is divided into two segments:

1. Weekly workshops covering a broad span of topics, including resumes, cover letters, industry overviews, and various interviewing techniques (both behavioral and industry-specific)
2. Panels and office hours in which you can receive tailored advice from the Mentorship Directors, Net Impact Eboard Members, and hear about our recruiting journeys!

Beyond programming, the Mentorship Program entails socials, a network of Net Impact upperclassmen you can lean on, and one-on-one pairing with a mentor. Filling out this form will help us understand your experiences with mentorship further so that we can pair you up with the best mentor!
