- You don't get an email if someone finds your AL
- Making me do it in a particular order
- I cannot contact the AL creator from the app if there is an issue, question, etc.
 - No way to know if something is wrong
- AL creators who put their stages on the ground (winter)
- Lack of cell service can be an issue sometimes
- Ambiguous questions and answers (adding words like feet for a distance instead of just a number)

• From a listener:

- Getting some of the information to answer the question can be difficult for one with a physical disability or bad eyesight. And, from what I can tell, one needs cell service and it is impossible to have an AL in a remote area as one can with a geocache.
- There is no one map that displays all the points of all the ALs in an area. With geocaches, I can go for a hike or bike ride along a trail and pick them up as I go along. ALs don't seem to be organized that way. And, going along a trail or street, one may pass the points of one AL while going to the points of another. This is especially annoying when 2 or more ALs use the same point, but I only trigger the proximity requirement for the answer to one of them.
- On the plus side, there is little chance of an AL being muggled.
 Additionally, I don't feel nearly as conspicuous looking for one in an urban setting as I do a container in a bush or under a lamp post skirt. Beyond that, the points are a lot more interesting than a basic lamp post or newspaper machine.
