



CAMPING GEAR CHECKLIST

Cub Scout Six Essentials

For each outdoor trip a cub scout should carry:

- FIRST AID KIT
- WATER BOTTLE
- FLASHLIGHT
- TRAIL FOOD
- SUNSCREEN
- WHISTLE

Individual Overnight Gear

For each camping trip each camper should carry:

- TENT
- SWEATPANTS (FOR SLEEPING)
- TOOTHPASTE, TOOTHBRUSH, SOAP, WASHCLOTH, TOWEL, COMB
- GROUND CLOTH
- CUP, BOWL, KNIFE, FORK, SPOON, MESH BAG (PACK 4 PROVIDES)
- DURABLE SHOES/BOOTS
- SLEEPING BAG
- INSECT REPELLENT
- HAT OR CAP
- PILLOW
- SUNSCREEN
- AIR MATTRESS/PAD
- EXTRA CLOTHING

Pack Camping Gear

In addition to the individual equipment above, each group of campers should carry:

- ACTIVITY GEAR (GAME MATERIAL, CRAFT SUPPLIES, ETC.)
- PLASTIC TRASH BAGS
- SHOVEL, AX, AND SAW
- ALUMINUM FOIL
- TOILET PAPER IN PLASTIC BAG
- NYLON CORD 50 FEET
- BACKPACKING STOVE AND FUEL OR FIREWOOD, CHARCOAL, AND COOKING GRATE
- COOKING UTENSILS
- ROPE 100-FOOT LENGTH
- MATCHES AND/OR BUTANE LIGHTERS FIRE STARTERS, CHARCOAL
- PAPER TOWELS
- COOLER
- PLASTIC WATER CONTAINERS
- EATING UTENSILS
- REPAIR KIT (RUBBER BANDS, SAFETY PINS, SEWING GEAR (THREAD, NEEDLES, SAFETY PINS))
- FIRST-AID KIT
- EXTRA TENT STAKES
- FOOD
- U.S. FLAG, PACK FLAG
- GROUND CLOTH OR TARP
- INSECT REPELLENT
- SUNSCREEN
